






ROUND TABLE MALAWI





As COVID-19 started tightening its grip on Africa during the first wave, conducting any (physical) fundraising was difficult due to the stringent rules and regulations put in place by the Malawi Government. Luckily, Round Table Malawi (RTMW) managed to organize a cancer and men's mental health awareness campaign while observing all the COVID-19 protocols.

In November 2020, Round Table Malawi was able to help spread awareness about cancer and mental health by handing out flyers that were written with the help of Dr. Kulisewa, a therapist who works with the College of Medicine in Blantyre. All the Tables in Malawi were involved including a potentially emerging Table in the Mzuzu area. The RTMW family is happy to announce its plans to start the 4th Table in the Mzuzu area!

As you can see from the pictures, the Tablers went to local grocery stores and other markets to ensure maximum reach of the Mental Awareness and Cancer Campaign.

Mental health is a serious problem in Malawi mostly because there is little education regarding the subject coupled with the fact that absence of proper diagnosis and



treatment facilities. Round Table Malawi continuously tries to educate diverse communities in the region about the dangers of mental health.



Many local Tablers participated in the "Movember" month campaign. Unfortunately, the actual Movember website does not work in Malawi. This initiative came from the idea of partnering up with local communities and the funds raised for this campaign were to be donated to the winner's choice of the charity organization! The participants in the initiative decided to grow their facial hair. RT Lilongwe 32 was lucky enough to have the "Master grower" Clayton Swart as a participant who ended up winning the title of the most grown facial hair and best design. He managed to





secure a whopping 1.2 mn kwacha(\$ 1.500) to be donated to the Oncology department in Blantyre at the Queen Elizabeth Central Hospital.

On February 20, 2021, RT Lilongwe 32 had the pleasure of hosting international Tablers during their AGM (via Zoom) which included the AMI Chairman Ibrahim Mojoo and CEE Regional Chairman John Clark as well as the RT Philippines President, Robin Clare-Talbot. The reason for the International Tablers to join the meet was the newly elected Chairman for RT Lilongwe 32, Michele Sabelli. He launched his Clubs' newest addition to their Legacy project 'Streetwise'. Streetwise is an organization run by a former street kid named Bezzel. He works hard to make sure that the street children he takes care of eat 3 meals per day, have proper accommodation, and also assures decent education. Streetwise was earning through selling beaded animals at the local farmers' market. However, due to the COVID-19 restrictions, all these markets have been closed indefinitely and there are not many places where they can be sold.

RT Lilongwe 32 decided to make a video to show other associations across the RTI World about their big plans for building a government accredited school that will educate these children about permaculture for sustainable farming.

- The board gave an overview of what is Round Table to the Guests. Multiple young people are interested in joining Round Table and the interested individuals will be invited for the next statutory meeting.








Collaboration with Round Table New Zealand – Christchurch 1: They donated US\$ 500 to Madagascar Round Table. The money will be used for community activities.

STORIES OF CHANGE



Lekker man lekker. That's one phrase I probably found my lifetime experience engraved in. Writing anything about my experience will do injustice since no words can be filling enough to describe my real feelings. From the moment I landed in SA till the moment I flew back, the weight of happy memories got heavier and heavier. Firstly, I won this privilege for almost no effort at all and secondly, I was treated like a royal guest which I doubted I deserved. Being my first visit to Africa, I had no practical knowledge about the culture and behavior of the country, but surprisingly it didn't take me a nanosecond to blend in and feel at home. Their hospitality is just class apart, I can't say it's royal but I can bet that it's so friendly and comfy that we won't miss our folks back home. In Africa, they always talk about "African time". They do not plan everything as we do in India but in some remarkable way it always ends up perfectly.

Starting from Vaal park and then riding through Potchefstroom, Klerksdorp, Carletonville, Rustenburg, Sun City, and landing at Emerald resort and the casino for the ARTSA before flying back from Sasolburg, every place, every home, and every person left a lasting impact on my heart. The Africans have unique ways of hosting guests. They not only open the doors of their house but also their hearts to make one feel at home. My experience on this trip was priceless. I don't say the places were fancy but I do say they were beautiful as I had the privilege of getting a first hand insight into their culture. We visited the lion farms, gold mines, shooting farms, Sun City, wildlife parks, museums, and the list goes on. A visit to the table clubhouses was another fascinating thing for me since we don't have anything of that type in India. We were hosted in every city.

Having visited so many places abroad, my trips have always been more tiresome than restful. But this trip was different. We were always at ease, waking up at the time we want, trying the cuisines we thought of, and chatting away the nights at leisure. This was simply a true vacation anyone can dream of. The only thing I'll refrain myself from mentioning here will be my "Bunny-Chow" experience. But that's what happens when the spicy Indian blends with sweet Africans. The Africans are a set of wonderful aliens on this land after Indians (LOL!). Every person I met connected instantly and then bid adieu painfully. Their sense of humor and point of perception is next level!

The ARTSA was another mind-blowing experience. Having my Chalet at Emerald resorts and casino was simply jaw-dropping and a mind-blowing WOW. The hippie party, Area food stall, hardcore hut, presidential banquet, banner exchange, and post AGM parties were all one of its kind experiences. We drank and danced and then danced and drank on a loop mode till dawn. Every minute detail from conveyance to lodging, from food to drinks, from pins to t-shirts were all well taken care of.





I don't have enough words in my vocabulary to describe my experience. Anything I say for the feelings I have for all the people I met would simply be an understatement. I thank each one of them for the ever-lasting impression they engraved in my heart and head forever. Since I made sure I don't take the name of anyone who hosted me at home or places around because each of them did their personal best for us and that's why this is one of my most memorable trips so far. But one person because of whom this dream turned into reality deserves to be mentioned is Schalk ... A hearty thanks to him and the entire STNOFS team who played part in gifting me the most treasured memory. Cannot help but agree with every word the RT motto says MEETING THE OLD FRIENDS FOR THE FIRST TIME.
