As always, if you have something to share or any suggestion what we can do to improve our movement, please feel free to reach out.

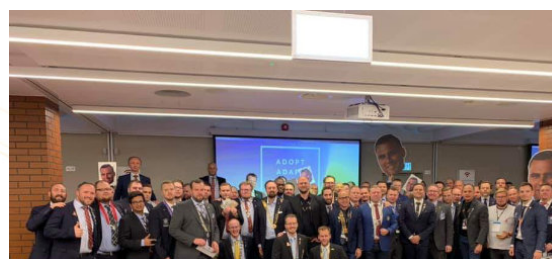

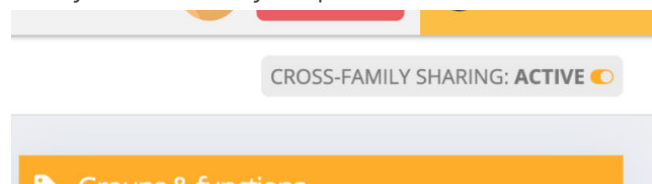

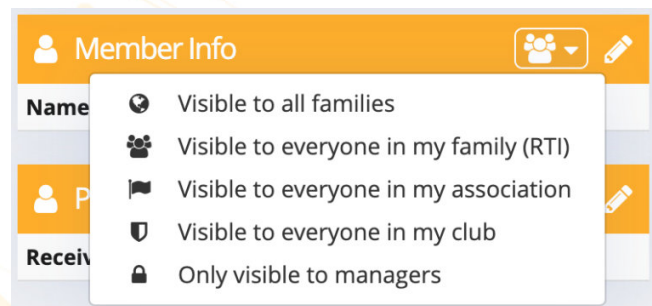
SHARE AND VIEW DATA

If you want to see data from cross family associations (e.g. Ladies Circle, Club41), you have to activate the sharing with cross family members. This you can do in your profile:

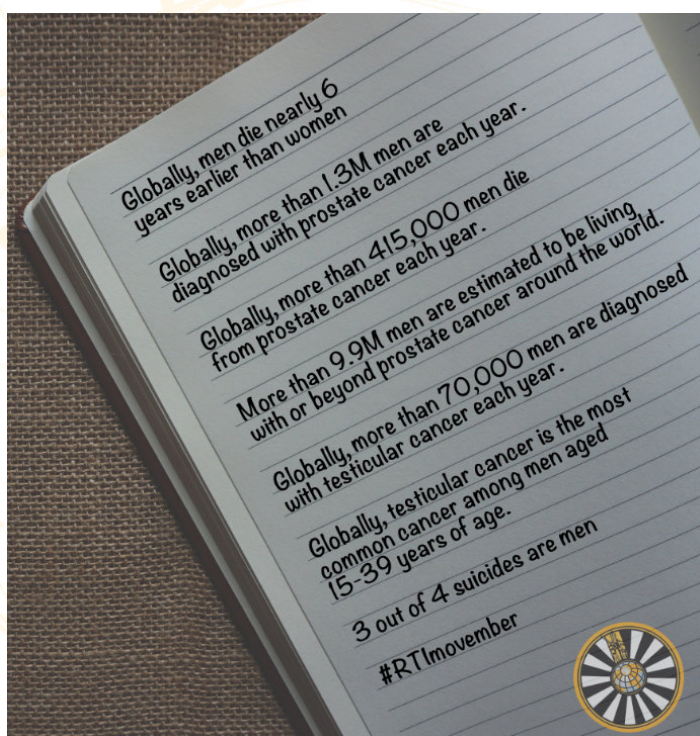


Only if the option "cross-family sharing" is active, you will see the data from the other cross-family associations.

The Northern Europe and Americas Tablers Meeting in Tallinn got attended by approx. 200 Tablers. Convenor Oliver and his team had put together a perfect weekend with a lots of work but also lots of fun, good food and activities for non delegates. Those included water-aerobics and bowling.

One of the main highlights of the week-end apart from the official NEATM were workshops. Since many associations participated with their entire board (e.g. Finland, Denmark, Sweden, Norway), it allowed conducting workshops for all the different board positions (i.e. for all Presidents, IRO, Webmasters, Treasurers). Later during the AGM the results about the know-how and exchange of experiences got presented. 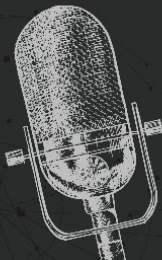

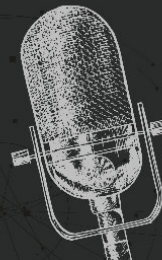

LA LA LA LA LA LA LA LA LA LA

Excerpt from the French Round Table Magazine

In Burgundy (France) we all know the legendary "boeuf bourguignon" dish, but in the end who really knows the origins of the "ban bourguignon", the story of our traditional Tabler song La-La-La?

So what is the origin of this "ban bourguignon"? There are several sources that agree and that it would be a little song that was created by a band of happy fellows. During an evening certainly well watered, they would have created this little musical phrase and would have completed this song of gestures, presumably by spinning bottles or glasses at the end of their hands.

If we search a little more, we discover that the "ban bourguignon" was born in Montchapet, East district of Dijon. Hence the name at the beginning of "ban de Montchapet". 1905 is the date around which was born the "ban bourguignon" during a meeting of jovial people and good drinkers.

Among this small group of bon vivants: the sculptor Jules Gasq and the bookseller Mettray meet at 20 Jacques-Cellerier Street, an appointment of poets and artists? It seems only no. There is no reason to say that they were doing anything other than drinking heavily, telling salty stories and singing popular songs.

It was Mettray who would have taught his companions the rite of the song. It is Jules Gasq who would have suggested the cheerfully "tra-la-la" and Lucien Dargentolle, a locksmith of the district, who would have composed the air.

For the gesture, it is not a question of toying the french kids song "Ainsi font, font, font. Les petites marionnettes", but bring your hands in the shape of a champagne glass to your face and turn them as if you were looking at the contents by transparency.

The history of this song could have stopped there, in the evenings of the "Bas de Montchapet", but it was not counting on a new unusual association that answers to the name of NPSFQQA (Ne Pas S'en Faire Quoi Qu'il Arrivee which means "Do not worry about it happening"), which in 1930 exports the ""ban de Montchapet" to the four corners of the city on the occasion of charity evenings.

It still a small change: finished hands raised above the head, only at the height of the chest and at the maximum of the shoulders. "Think of the nectar that you see before tasting it! "

After disappearing during the vSecond World War, it is re-used during the wine festivals and spread throughout Burgundy. It becomes the hymn of identity of the region and takes its current name of "Ban Bourguignon".

And finally, it is after the 10 years of the Round Table of Dijon 202 in 1983 that the "Ban Bourguignon" spreads through all the Tables de France and becomes a real hymn for the Tablers de France and today for the Tablers of the world!

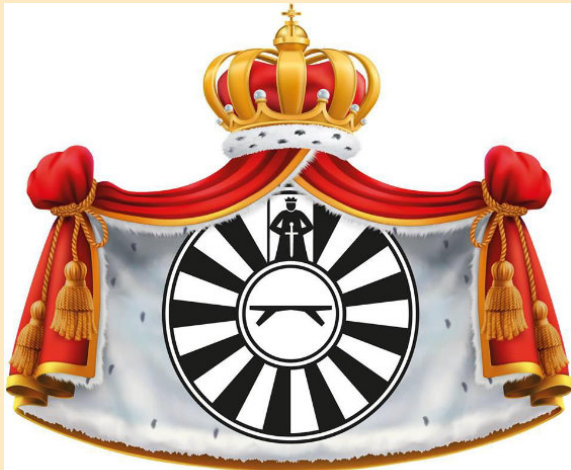

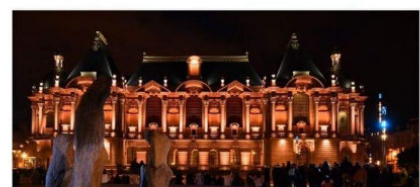
